

### **MUSIC NOTES**

### "THE OLD RUGGED CROSS"

When they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives. Matthew 26:30 & Mark 14:26 (NIV)

The familiar words above are translated exactly the same in the New International Version of the gospels of Mark and Matthew. The scene is the conclusion of the Lord's Supper as Jesus and His disciples depart the upper room and journey to the Garden of Gethsemane. It is the only time mentioned in the gospels when Jesus and His followers would sing. Biblical scholars generally agree that their choice of texts of praise was probably one of the "Hallel" Psalms (113-118).

We know very little about what first century Jewish and Christian hymnody or psalmody would have sounded like, but the important part is to know that they did sing a hymn or psalm of praise. That verse began a tradition of singing during Passion Week that exists to this day. We follow the example set by our Lord in remembering His sacrifice on the cross through hymns like "The Old Rugged Cross," or a hymn that celebrates His victory over death such as "Christ the Lord Is Risen Today." These are important actions that remind us of God's act of redemption through His One and Only Son and allow us to sing praise to Him.

Holy Week services this year at Fern Creek offers contrasting views that convey the significant events that occurred in the last week of the life of Jesus. The Maundy Thursday service will feature a "Silent Lord's Supper" where the only sound heard will be that of the organ. The worship bulletin and the screen will guide us through the steps of this worship experience designed to allow us to hear God's Spirit in His printed word. The Good Friday service will feature the choir, narrators, piano, organ, flute, and cello leading in a musical worship experience titled "The Final Hours."

Please take this opportunity to attend these services as well as one of the two Easter morning services. Plus, it is a great time to invite someone to church as many folks are more open to such invitations than at any other time.
