## LINDA'S LINES

Matthew 28:19-20 says: Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshiped him, but some doubted. Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. Pray for all of these households to know Jesus as Savior.
We will begin the visits on April 24, 10:00 a.m. We need folks who will go to the doors and those who will be drivers for those who will be doing the visiting. We need people to put the evangelistic bags together. We need all to pray and be involved in this endeavor. How will you help?
June 6, 10:45 a.m. is Harvest Sunday. We gather in worship to rejoice in all that God has done through this evangelistic emphasis and to pray for Vacation Bible School which will begin the next day.

We hope our entire church family will participate in this initiative! Please hear again the words that Jesus spoke to His disciples in Matthew 9:37-38: "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field". Will you be intentional about being workers in His harvest field?

Please continue to pray for God's kingdom to come on earth! Continue to pray, "Lord, awaken Your people and send a great revival!"
