MUSIC NOTES

Steve Skaggs, Interim Minister of Music

GREETINGS!

The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you. Romans 16:20 (NIV)

In his letter to the Romans, Paul presents his basic statement of the gospel leading us today to sometimes talk about the "Romans Road to Salvation" (verses chosen from throughout the epistle that explain how to be saved). But Paul's longest letter and his other epistles also include a lot of personal information that is important for us to not overlook.

In Romans 16, Paul begins to close his letter with personal greetings mentioning many people by name. This must have been very encouraging for the fledgling churches in the capital city of the powerful empire. As I come to the close of my time of interim with you, I am drawn to this chapter precisely because of these names. Like Paul encouraging the believers at Rome, I want you to know that you are not alone. There are people in sister churches standing with you in prayerful obedience to the gospel.

Paul also gives some advice and warnings to which I will add:

- Greet one another affectionately. (16:16)
- Watch out for divisions and obstacles. (16:17)
- Get excited about the gospel and in turn about the church.
- Support your staff.
- Pray earnestly for God to fill the positions at the church pray with expectation!
- If you have not been physically involved in coming to church recently, find a way to overcome the obstacles that are blocking your path. Everyone is important! Everyone is needed!

What a joy it has been to work with your staff, especially Pastor Linda. As I have told many people, she just may be the hardest working and most evangelistic pastor with which I have ever worked. What a blessing for me and Shirley to count her and George as close friends.
