TAKE THE NAME OF JESUS WITH YOU

Precious name, O how sweet! Hope of earth and joy of heaven.

"Take the Name of Jesus with You" is a gospel hymn in our hymnal (#576) included in the section titled "EVANGELISM AND MISSIONS." As we continue to pray for and otherwise actively participate in "The Gospel to Every Home," perhaps it offers some encouragement for us

If you remember the text of this old hymn or have a hymnal handy, please examine it with me.

- The first stanza reminds us that God wants to comfort us in our sorrow. "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." Matthew 11:28.
- The second stanza tells us the name of Jesus is a shield against temptation. "For since He Himself [Jesus] was tempted in that which He suffered, He is able to come to the aid of those who are tempted." Hebrews 2:18.
- The third stanza reminds us of the joy we should have as Christians. "Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I will say, rejoice!" Philippians 4:4.
- The fourth and final stanza encourages us in our journey here on earth. "But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ." Philippians 3:2.

This gospel song is the only hymn written by a lady named Lydia Baxter, an American Baptist from New York, that is still in many hymnals. However, she did author a number of hymns and poems, many of which were published in the mid-19th century, for use in Sunday Schools and evangelistic services. She apparently had a heart for evangelism and helped establish a Baptist church in Petersburg, New York. Her hymn reminds us that we do not necessarily need to be speaking directly about evangelism to be evangelistic. We just need to take the name of Jesus with us wherever we go. The Holy Spirit will do the work!

Her biographical entry in *Handbook to the Baptist* Hymnal, (Convention Press, 1992) begins, "Lydia Baxter was an enthusiastic Christian." I thought that strange when I first read it—sort of a back-handed compliment. But, in reconsideration, I am thinking, what a compliment! Let us all be enthusiastic Christians all the time and especially during this time when we are taking "The Gospel to Every Home."


