Robert Lowry, a Baptist preacher, would often be so inspired by the events at \$\frac{1}{8}\$ his church on each Sunday that he would sit down at his pump organ at the end of the day and write a hymn. It was Easter 1874 when, inspired by the words of Luke 24:6, "He is not here, but is risen," he wrote both the text and \$\frac{1}{8}\$ music for this beloved resurrection hymn.

"Low in the Grave He Lay" is not one of those hymns we sing a lot outside of Easter Sunday. Yet its message is true for any Sunday and, in fact, for any and every day. Jesus promised, "Because I live, you also will live" [John 14:19b, NIV]. The Apostle Paul put it this way in I Corinthians

15:5657: "The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." [NIV]
