

Watering Our Southern Roots

Have you ever thought about how the disciples felt when Jesus asked them to leave their families, their homes, their jobs to follow him? We take it that because Jesus asked them, they simply left everything they held dear and eagerly followed Him. Ever wonder the struggles they had, questions they were asked, details they had to take care of before leaving their homes? Most were men who worked to support families and had jobs. Family members depended on them for survival. These men were not going on vacation. They did not know how long their commitment to follow Him would last. They had no idea where they would journey or whether they could ever return home. Can you imagine the faith those men had? What courage to step out on faith and do what God was calling them to do with their lives! "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." Jeremiah 29:11

We all love going on vacation – no question about a few days or a week or two of relaxing, sightseeing, and renewing our spirit. Most of us will agree it is just as exciting to "come home". Home holds a special place in our hearts and creates a feeling of peace and contentment. We like being in familiar surroundings, knowing people, having favorite restaurants and simply being in our comfort zones.

Recently, we went home after being gone for several months. It was a little bit of heaven on earth!!! Familiar faces, roads, landmarks, foods (gotta love Chic-fil-a!), and a sense of being in a place we love. There are no words to describe "watering our Southern roots". It was long overdue.
