Thanks so much to those of you who prayed for our team during the recent Honduras Mission Trip. Thanks to those of you who made masks and salvation dolls for us to give to the people in the villages we visited. The masks and dolls were greatly appreciated by the people. We stayed in La Esperanza and traveled each day to surrounding villages to share the gospel through witnessing to the people, giving them clothing and supplies, and providing medicines through mini-clinics. 

FIND YOUR PLACE

Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it. I Corinthians 12:27 (NIV)

The verse above is from familiar instructions the Apostle Paul gave to the church at Corinth concerning finding their place as individuals in the church, the Body of Christ. I like the title of the section (verses 12-31) in the NIV: "Unity and Diversity in the Body." Yes! There can be unity in diversity when we seek to find our place in God's kingdom!

The following are just a few things to consider when seeking to find your place.

- What are my gifts? The passage from Corinthians addresses that. Take just a few moments to read it and ask for new insight.
- Can I encourage someone else in finding their gift? Yes, you can! In the case of music, for example, you may hear someone singing during worship and recognize that they have a beautiful voice. Encourage them to consider joining the choir. They just may be waiting for affirmation from someone. If they are unsure, they can talk to me or Pastor Linda or any member of the choir.
- Finding our place promotes unity. "There should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other," Paul wrote in verse 25. I am tasked to work in the area of music and worship but my concern must be with the health of the ministry and work of the whole church!
- Finding your place means that someone else will not have to pull double or triple (or more) duty in filling the needs of the Body.

Do not be afraid to seek the place God has for you in His church. In fact, as Paul wrote in ending this section of Corinthians, let us be eager in finding our place!

Now eagerly desire the greater gifts. I Corinthians 12:31 (NIV)
