3) in La Esperanza, Honduras! Please join us on Sunday, August 25, 6:00 p.m., as we share those experiences with you during evening worship. Thank you for your tremendous prayer and financial support for the team.

We give God the glory for what He did in La Esperanza! Our mission team included a total of 49 people from Alabama, Florida, Kentucky, Mississippi, North Carolina, and Tennessee. We worked with Pastor Gervacio Figueroa, the pastor of Transformation Baptist Church; and we were under the supervision of Noe Alvarez of Baptist Medical and Dental Mission International.

How glorious it was for 122 people to accept Jesus as Savior! 50 professions of faith were made during the Tent Services; 37 were made during Children's Church; one was made in the Medical Clinic; 50 were from the school; five were from the Veterinary / Mountain Ministry; 29 were from Street Evangelism. There were 64 public rededications to Christ during the Tent Crucifixion, and Resurrection. Services.

Our Veterinary / Mountain Ministry treated 78 cows and one pig. They had many witnessing experiences in various places throughout the surrounding areas. They disbursed Bibles, beans, rice, medicines, food, and clothing to the people of San Miguelito, La Paz, and the Transformation Church's satellite church. They witnessed to the people through personal evangelism and preaching.

The Medical Clinic treated 3,252 patients (2,183 were female; 1,069 were male) in La Esperanza. They treated others in the mountain villages. 50 people received physical therapy in the clinic.

We distributed 2,000 bags of rice and 2,000 bags of beans totaling over \$8,000. The rice and beans were given away through the Medical Clinic and through the Mountain Ministry.

We look forward to sharing with you all that Seven people were referred to the Project God did during our week (July 27 – August Life program for an approximate total of \$500. Some of the cases are closed and completed. Others are still open as needs continue to be assessed.

> The Pharmacy dispensed 18,596 prescriptions. Each family received toiletries, toothbrushes, tracts, etc. in their bags.

> The Optical Clinic saw 908 patients. An auto refractor was used to measure their eves. The clinic dispensed 184 pairs of prescription eyeglasses, 354 readers, and 290 sunglasses.

> The Dental Clinic treated 218 patients and extracted 291 teeth. They gave away dental instructions, toothpaste, and toothbrushes.

There were eight sessions of Children's Church for a total of 607 children. The average attendance was 76. The children heard stories about Creation, Jonah, the Ten Commandments. Jesus and the Children, the Feeding of the 5,000, and the Great Commission, as well as Jesus' Birth.

There were 76 boxes of shoes and 280 boxes of clothing given out in the Shoe and Clothing Ministries. Everyone who went through the medical clinic received clothing.

The Photography Ministry photographed over 800 families/individuals. The pictures were given to the people in a colorful BMDMI brochure.

We distributed 960 New Testaments, 688 complete Bibles, 100 Gideon Bibles, 400 Beginning Steps (New Believer's) Books, 3,900 John/Romans, and approximately 500 salvation dolls. Some of the Bibles were left for the local church and others to distribute.

The kitchen crew made sure we all (including the missionaries, national staff, translators, guards, and others) were well fed. Victor and Bobby kept the compound running!!




