Music Notes

REVIVAL IN ADVERSITY

The words of Nehemiah son of Hakaliah:

In the month of Kislev in the twentieth year, while I was in the citadel of Susa, Hanani, one of my brothers, came from Judah with some other men, and I questioned them about the Jewish remnant that had survived the exile, and also about Jerusalem.

They said to me, "Those who survived the exile and are back in the province are in great trouble and disgrace. The wall of Jerusalem is broken down, and its gates have been burned with fire."

When I heard these things, I sat down and wept. For some days I mourned and fasted and prayed before the God of heaven.

[Nehemiah 1:1-4, NIV]

Thus began the book of Nehemiah which describes the rebuilding of the walls of Jerusalem as the Israelites were being repatriated to their home land. The temple had been rebuilt but it was a layperson named Nehemiah who saw the need for a wall of protection around the city of Jerusalem.

Let me encourage you to read this short Old Testament book while considering the following outline that I believe is applicable to us during this unusual time.

Repent (1:4). Nehemiah wept, mourned, fasted, and prayed. Verse 6 tells us that Nehemiah's sorrow led him to repentance. Paul wrote in II Corinthians 7:10 that "Godly sorrow brings repentance."

Rebuild (2:4-5). Following his repentance, Nehemiah took action that was bathed in prayer. John the Baptist preached, "Bear fruit in keeping with repentance" (Matthew 3:8). True repentance is evidenced by what we do.

Revive (8 & 9). Revival was based on God's word. "They listened attentively" (8:3) as the priest, Ezra, read from the Torah. They worshiped, confessed, and remembered their deliverance. Then the people received assurance: "Do not grieve, for the joy of the Lord is your strength" (8:10).

Reform (10-13). Revival led to being re-formed--that is, re-made or made new. They pledged, "We will not neglect the house of our God" (10:39). **This included bringing their tithes and offerings into the storerooms (13:12).**

We may feel that, like the Israelites of Nehemiah's day, we have been exiled from our place of worship during this time of pandemic. But, whether you are coming to church or staying connected from home, God can use this time of adversity to bring revival.


