A DREAM OF CHRISTMAS

Matthew 1 tells how an angel of the Lord visited Joseph in a dream and revealed the truth behind the predicament in which his betrothed, Mary, found herself. "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit," said the angel. A miraculous dream giving Divine guidance to Joseph and revealing the fulfillment of God's promise of a Deliverer!

Many of us have happy dreams of Christmas. Kids dream about the gifts they will receive and families look forward to getting together. Our hearts are warmed every year when we see news stories about a soldier surprising his family by unexpectedly returning from overseas deployment. You may know of someone who is dreaming of being released from the hospital in time for Christmas. What are your Christmas dreams?

Every year there are also sad stories at Christmas. It may be the loss of a loved one, an illness, broken relationships, or financial struggles. Or it can be something historically catastrophic on the other side of the world like the tsunami that occurred in the Indian Ocean the day after Christmas, 2004. This year a catastrophe of historic proportions happened in our own state (and neighboring states) with the recent tornadoes. The Christmas dreams of many have been dashed in the wake of this death and destruction.

I don't know that anyone will have a miraculous dream like Joseph — a dream that answered the questions he had concerning something going on in his life that he could not understand — that will give answers to why this happened. And I don't know that we can really do anything to restore the dreams of Christmas, 2021 for those who were in the path of these massive tornadoes. But, as Joseph was faithful in following the Lord's word to him, we can also be faithful in following the teachings we should know so well. We can give financially to any number of relief agencies who are on the ground offering immediate assistance to the people in affected areas.

We can do what we can do. We can pray. We can give. We can perhaps even go. God hasn't revealed that to us in a miraculous dream but, in His word.
