It is supervised by missionaries Karl and Beth Brassfield. The Emmanuel Home of Protection cares for girls, mostly eighteen and under, who have been subjected to abuse. Many of the girls still have families, but have been removed from their families because of the abuse they received. The goal of this ministry is to provide a secure and loving environment for these girls and to minister to them spiritually, emotionally, and physically with the love of Christ. Our team will be partnering with the Brassfields to do just that. We will also be working with the Mount of Olives Baptist Church in San Gregorio. (Jodie Towles will be our contact person while we are away.) If you are willing to help financially with any of the team members, please contact me and I will let you know who needs help. We also need more money for the Nicaragua general fund for Bibles, children's supplies, and roofing materials and paint for the Mount of Olives Baptist Church. Thank you for being a church on mission!

Dr. Terry Wilder will preach in my absence on the morning of January 8. You will be blessed through his message that day. I know you are grateful for Terry's ministry with our church. He has been a blessing to us.


