THE LOVE OF GOD

Valentine's Day, or perhaps, more completely, Saint Valentine's Day, is approaching. There are many legends associated with the day and with one or more Christians from the early Roman period that may have been the "saint" whose feast day would be celebrated on February 14. Sometime around the 14th or 15th centuries the festival became associated with courtly love and here we are in the 21st century still celebrating love on this day! But, as we approach this day, I want to share with you the story of a song that tells us of the greatest love—God's love.

There is a gospel song or hymn titled "The Love of God" that was written by a man named Frederick M. Lehman in 1917. For me, the definitive performances of the song were given by George Beverly Shea in many of the Billy Graham Crusades through the years. Shea would begin with the first stanza written by Lehman, singing in his inimitable style.

"The love of God is greater far than tongue or pen can ever tell; It goes beyond the highest star, and reaches to the lowest hell. Oh, love of God, how rich and pure How measureless and strong; It shall forevermore endure the saints and angel's song."

Shea would then recite this poem as the organist continued to play quietly:

"We can only see a little of the ocean as we stand on the rocky shore, but out there beyond the eye's horizon, there's more, there's more; We can only see a little of God's loving, a few rich treasures from His mighty store, but out there beyond the horizon, there's more, there's more."

George Beverly Shea had a marvelous bass/baritone voice of which he had masterful control. After the recitation, he would begin to sing the third stanza of Rev. Lehman's song (omitting the second stanza).

"Could we with ink the ocean fill, and were the skies of parchment made; were ev'ry stalk on earth a quill, and ev'ryone a scribe by trade; To write the love of God above would drain the ocean dry; nor could the scroll contain the whole, though stretched from sky to sky."

According to Lehman he had borrowed the words of this stanza that had been found written on the walls of a prison cell around 200 years earlier. Many years later a man named Alfred B. Smith, who had been a classmate of Billy Graham at Wheaton College, discovered that the final stanza of "The Love of God" had apparently been translated from a Hebrew poem written by Meir Ben Isaac, a Jewish Rabbi, around 1,000 AD.

It is amazing how God uses various people to remind us of His love. His love is truly "greater than any tongue or pen can tell"

"This is love; not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins." I John 4:10.
