

### Rocky Hardymon - Minister of Music

We are in the Lenten Season. According to Merriam Webster, Lent derives from the Old Middle English "lente" meaning springtime, which is related to a German word "lenzin," which means spring. We think of spring as a time of refreshing when all things are made new again. Flowers spring forth and trees begin to bud. The process for this new birth is not easy though and doesn't just happen overnight. Trees shed their leaves in the fall and stand stark and cold in the winter lying dormant waiting for new life. 
