LINDA'S LINES

Wednesday, March 1, is the first day of Lent. Ash Wednesday is the name given to this day in which some Christians have ashes applied to their foreheads in the shape of a cross to signify an inner repentance. In early days Lent was a time of preparation of candidates for baptism on Easter Sunday. During the season of Lent these candidates prepared for this initiation into the Christian life. Lent for us is not only a time of preparation; it is also a time of prayer, repentance, sacrifice, soul-searching, self-denial, and service. Sundays, which are days for commemorating the resurrection, are omitted in counting the forty days of reflection and repentance. The color purple is used during this time to symbolize repentance and solemnity.

The forty weekdays (Sundays are excluded.) in the season of Lent symbolize the forty-day fasts of Moses, Elijah, and Jesus. The focus of Lent is for Christians to imitate Jesus' withdrawal into the wilderness for forty days. During Lent some Christians make decisions to give up some food, activity, etc. Some may give up Facebook (or other social media), television, or anything they need to get rid of in order to hear God's voice more <u>clearly</u>. These days are basically six weeks of self-discipline.

Our deacons are calling our church to participate in a fast during the Lenten season beginning on March 1. (You are to choose the particular form of fasting for yourself.) The purpose of this fast is to ask God to send a great revival among us! Will you join us in fasting for revival? God called the people of Judah to a time of fasting through the prophet Joel. Joel 2:15 says: "Blow the trumpet in Zion, declare a holy fast, call a sacred assembly." The deacons are calling for such a holy fast. Our prayer is that you will participate and that great revival will begin in your soul. Pray and sing these words by B.B. McKinney as a part of your prayer and fasting:

Send a great revival in my soul, Send a great revival in my soul; Let the Holy Spirit come and take control, And send a great revival in my soul.

As the sacred season of Lent concludes with Holy Week, join me in great expectation of a joyous Easter and glorious days to follow! "Lord, Send a Great Revival!"
