THE PAUSE THAT REFRESHES

A generous man will prosper; he who refreshes others will himself be refreshed. Proverbs 11:25 (NIV)

In the 1920's Coca-Cola was looking for a slogan that would encourage Americans to slow down and enjoy a bottle of their soft drink. In 1923 their ad agency came up with the following: "Pause and refresh yourself. Our nation is the busiest in earth. From breakfast to dinner there's no end of work." By 1929 these words were seen as too negative so they came up with an altered version, "The pause that refreshes," a slogan that was still in use when I first saw a Coke machine in the 1950's.

This iconic American brand was looking for a slogan to help them sell more of their product—to make more money for their company. God's word encourages us to "pause and refresh" for a more holy reason. Genesis 2:3 tells us how God "blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it He rested from all the work of creating that He had done." In giving the ten commandments to Moses, God continued to promote the idea of a "Sabbath day" in the fourth commandment. Leviticus 25 continues to grow the idea into a "Sabbath year" and a "Year of Jubilee," extended times of rest and focus on God. Even the land was to have rest from growing crops!

As Pastor Linda has embarked on a "Sabbath" (or sabbatical as we call it today) she will be taking time to rest, renew, reflect, and refocus. Let us all join together in continuous prayer for her during this time as well as asking God to bring revival to us as a congregation and supply the staffing needs of the church. This is something we can all do even when we may not be attending in-person services. The proverb above reminds us that Linda is generous with her time in ministry and brings refreshment to those in need. But, as with anyone, she requires this time as well so that she may continue her work—the Lord's work—effectively.

Thank you, Fern Creek Baptist, for your encouraging support of ministers and staff. Let the words of a familiar gospel hymn below guide us in our prayer.

There shall be showers of blessing: Send them upon us, O Lord; Grant to us now a refreshing, Come, and now honor Thy word.
