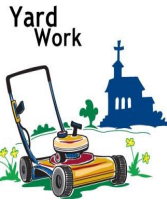

YOUTH AND CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Why abroad? This is the question many people ask when they hear of foreign missions. The answer to that question is a loaded one. We need to be a witness for Christ wherever we are; however, to go is not so much a choice, but a command. **Matthew 28:19 - Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.** Sure our nation needs to hear the gospel too, but when they have heard the message and are not willing to accept it, what are we to do? **Matthew 10:14 - If anyone will not welcome you or listen to your words, leave that home or town and shake the dust off your feet.** There are millions of unreached people in the world who have never heard, and will not, unless someone is willing to go tell them. **Romans 10:14 - How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them?** We have had the opportunity this week to share the message of Jesus Christ with the people in Honduras. Yes, it is a long way from home. Yes, it is expensive to go. Yes, they speak a different language; but scripture doesn't leave room for excuses. **Acts 1:8 - But you'll receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you, and you'll be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.** Please continue to pray for all the missionaries who will be traveling and that the message of Jesus Christ would be shared with boldness.
