Sing a new song to the Lord!

Let the whole earth sing to the Lord!

Sing to the Lord; praise his name.

Each day proclaim the good news that he saves.

Psalm 96: 1-2 (NLT)

Music Week is here! It is a time for preschool and elementary students to learn songs that point them to the message of the gospel. God loves us! Let us join together in singing out and living out His praise!

The school-age students will learn a musical titled "Daniel, Darius & DeLions." The first song of the musical is based on the words of Psalm 96 printed above. Verse 5, included in the song says, "For all the gods of the nations are idols, but the Lord made the heavens" (NIV). I'm sure the author/composer of the musical chose this psalm because it fit the situation in which Daniel found himself. Daniel was accused of praying to his God during a time when it was illegal to do so. King Darius had hastily issued an ill-advised decree that no one could pray to any god or man except for King Darius for thirty days. The enemies of Daniel knew that he would not fail to continue to pray to his God, the true and living God who made the heavens. In the musical, Daniel's enemies sing, "There's only one way we can trick him: It's his religiosity," as they hatch their evil plot to get Daniel thrown in the den of lions. You know the rest of the story. Their evil plot failed and Daniel remained true and faithful.

Along with the biblically-based concepts, both groups of students will be learning about music and singing. But it all will point to Jesus and the message of the gospel and, perhaps, it will make a positive impact on students that will remain with them into their adult years. Encourage your preschool and elementary students to join us!
