# **LINDA'S LINES**

One of our church members made some comments to me as she was passing through the line a few Sundays ago. I was so touched by the things she said that I asked her to write her thoughts in a devotional form. Please read the following:

The world, our nation, and especially our city, spent several days mourning the passing of Muhammad Ali. Mourners and faithful fans built makeshift memorials. Concerts were being held in his honor. People of all faiths were holding prayer vigils. You didn't have to leave home to hear the praises of this Louisville native; you just had to turn on you television, radio, or any form of social media. Talk of Ali was everywhere. Everyone had words of praise for the one who is said to have done so much for his fellow man, regardless of their race, religions, or economic standing. He changed the lives of many people. He became an inspiration to many. I was very saddened by his passing, as well. I was saddened by the fact that while he was worshipped by the world, he didn't know the One who created the world. Ali will never have eternal life with Jesus and the Heavenly Father because he chose to worship Allah, instead of Jesus Christ, the One and Only Lord

It was said that Ali was trying to earn his way to heaven by doing good works. My ten-year-old grandson was quite puzzled when he heard this. He remembered learning that the only way to heaven was through Jesus. My grandson questioned me and this gave me the opportunity to discuss salvation with him and make sure he understood the price Jesus paid for our sins. It took a while, but in the end he understood that just saying you believe in Jesus in not enough. You also have to believe that you are a sinner and ask God to forgive you of your sins. You must believe that Jesus died on the cross to pay your sin debt in full, and on the third day He arose to live forever in heaven where He has prepared a place for us. I thank God for giving me the opportunity to have that conversation with my grandson and possibly plant a seed.

On the day of Ali's funeral I had my television on while going about my chores. I decided to take a break and I sat down in front of the television. I watched as the hearse carrying Ali's body was making its way through the streets of Louisville. Thousands of people were lining the streets. They were tossing flowers onto the hearse, kissing their fingertips and placing them on the car as if they were giving Ali one last kiss. They were chanting his name over and over. ALI! ALI! ALI! My eyes started to sting as the tears welled up. I couldn't help but think about another man who made His way through the streets as the crowds gathered to watch. Except those people weren't throwing flowers, they were throwing stones. They were not wanting to kiss Him; they were spitting on Him. He wasn't being carried royally as a king while the crowd paid their last respects, but He was walking, at times crawling, under the weight of the wooden cross He was carrying. The cross that He would be nailed to, the cross on which He would die! My Savior died for me. He died for Muhammad Ali. He died for all the people who were 'worshipping" Ali. My tears poured.

One of the local news anchors made the statement that Ali was a "Modern Day Jesus". I'm sorry, but as far as I know, Ali is still in the grave and it has been a lot longer than three days...






