As Kentucky Baptists cooperate to get the gospel to the 1,728,681 homes in Kentucky by November 2021, we know that we must pray, pray, and pray! Since more than 81% of Kentuckians were unchurched pre-COVID, there has never been greater urgency to get the gospel to every home! We will be distributing the prayer guides in the coming days and more details are forthcoming. I hope that our entire church family will participate in this much needed venture. Please carry Jesus' words (the Great Commission) in your hearts and minds: "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." (Matthew 28:18-20)

During this Lenten season we continue to focus on Jesus' journey during the last month of His life on earth. During the remaining Sundays prior to Holy Week, we will focus on the following:

Please do not give to this in place of your tithe. We will follow the same sanitary procedures with the Easter Bags as last year. The Children's Committee and Preschool Committee will give more details soon.
