I LOVE CHURCH

I was glad when they said to me, "Let us go to the house of the Lord!". Psalm 122:1

I remember receiving a note from a little girl in my classroom when I was in the second grade that said:

I love you. Do you love me? Check yes__ or no__.

I don't remember what I checked (probably yes) but I do remember sending the note back to her. It is amazing that I still remember that 61 years later. It was significant to me, not just because of who the girl was, but mainly, because someone—anyone—noticed me and took the time to reach out.

Two years later it was discovered that my mother, a first-grade teacher, had a brain tumor that would require surgery. She had the procedure as soon as the school year ended. Unfortunately, she would never come home and would die in a Louisville care facility on Christmas Eve, 1962 at age 52. I was a nine-year-old fourth grader.

Church had been important to me all of my life. Some of my earliest memories are of Sunday School or sitting with my dad in church and joining my kid voice with his bass voice on the hymns. I loved laying in his lap and looking up at his face as he bowed his head and closed his eyes in prayer. I am so thankful that church—that God—would be there to help me through this rough time.

Around six months after my mother passed away, I received another love note; this one from God. "I love you. Do you love Me?", He asked. I'm not sure how much dealing with Mom's death had to do with the conviction I felt at that time and my need for greater understanding of spiritual things, but I came to know that I was a sinner and needed to confess that and profess Christ as my Savior. I checked yes!

The First Baptist Church of Hodgenville (the black congregation) sits just a block south of where I now live. It has a stained-glass window on the front that caught my eye as a first grader. There is a big question mark in the center with the caption, "God loves you. Do you love Him?"

As a minister I have had many church members going through some kind of trouble say to me through the years, "Steve, I just can't imagine how people who don't believe in God and have a loving church family make it through something like this." As a nine-year-old I experienced that very thing in my life and I am so thankful for that true sanctuary that has always been a part of my life.

Do you love God? Like David, are you glad when your church family reaches out and says, "Let us go to the house of the Lord?" This month marks the second anniversary of our shut-down for the pandemic. I would not ask anyone to do anything to compromise their health. But, if you have not come back to church physically, would you consider doing so? Would you find a way?

There are folks at Fern Creek Baptist and people in the community who need your support during rough times and to see and hear the testimony of your attendance. Will you check, yes?
