I WILL SING OF MY REDEEMER

A review of the "Topical Index of Hymns" in the back of the 1991 edition of *The Baptist Hymnal* (the hymnal in our pews) reveals that we Baptists do certainly like to sing about Jesus, our Redeemer. Look specifically at the fifteen topics that begin with the name of our Lord and you will see many titles that deal with His blood, His cross, and the resurrection. Paul, in I Corinthians 15, said, "For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures" (verses 3-4). Paul called this the gospel—the good news that Christ had defeated death, that death had been "swallowed up in victory."

As we come to our special Holy Week services you will hear the gospel proclaimed through the reading of Scripture, the Sermons by Pastor Linda, the prayers, and the songs and hymns. What a time to witness to the love and grace of God. He truly loved a lost and dying world so much that "He gave His only begotten Son" as John 3:16 tells us.

Beginning on Palm Sunday and culminating with Easter Sunday, Christians around the world will join their voices in singing songs of the cross and the resurrection during Holy Week. Many favor time-honored gospel hymns like "The Old Rugged Cross" while others like new expressions of faith through contemporary praise and worship songs such as Chris Tomlin's "At the Cross (Love Ran Red)." One of my favorite choral works for Holy Week is Handel's chorus "Worthy Is the Lamb" from *Messiah* which is followed by an extended choral "Amen."

Whatever you favor personally when it comes to style of church music, the most important thing, as preached by Paul in I Corinthians 15, is to proclaim Christ and to remember that "by this gospel you are saved." Will you invite someone to worship with us this year during Holy Week? Given the use of technology it is easier than ever. You will see a variety of opportunities as you scan the church calendar. There is someone you know that the Spirit is calling you to reach out to and invite them to come to church—to come to Jesus.

I Will sing of my Redeemer And His wondrous love to me; On the cruel cross He suffered From the curse to set me free.
