#### Wednesday, March 6, is the first day of Lent. Ash Wednesday is the name given to this day in which some Christians have ashes applied to their foreheads in the shape of a cross to signify an inner repentance. In early days Lent was a time of preparation of candidates for baptism on Factor Sunday. During the account of

on Easter Sunday. During the season of Lent these candidates prepared for this initiation into the Christian life. Lent for us is not only a time of preparation; it is also a time of prayer, repentance, sacrifice, soul-searching, self-denial, and service. Sundays, which are days for commemorating the resurrection, are omitted in counting the forty days of reflection and repentance. The color purple is used during this time to symbolize repentance and solemnity.

The forty weekdays in the season of Lent symbolize the forty-day fasts of Moses, Elijah, and Jesus. The focus of Lent is for Christians to imitate Jesus' withdrawal into the wilderness for forty days. During Lent some Christians make decisions to give up some food, activity, etc. These days are basically six weeks of selfdiscipline. Fasting can be a good thing, and God is pleased when we repent of sinful habits. However, we must remember that repenting of sin is something we should be doing all days of the year, not just during Lent. The sacred season of Lent concludes with Holy Week. Holy Week is a time of reflection upon the suffering and death of Jesus Christ. Holy Week leads us to the joyous and glorious season of Easter.

During the Lenten Season (and the Sunday prior to Lent) I will be preaching a sermon series entitled "Jesus' Seven Last Words from the Cross". The sermons are as follows:






