

Each team that began the season in \$\frac{1}{8}\$ November is hoping to have played well enough to be invited to the tournament. But, what makes a team successful? Many things, including individual disciplines such as diet and exercise, and being responsible for being on time at practices. But, what separates good teams from great teams is teamwork, working together to make each member of a team to be successful. When individuals think it is all about them, then teamwork suffers, regardless of how athletic or talented they are. Players have to grow up and realize that to be a man, you have to put others first.

Speaking of learning to be a man, we read in *Numbers 16* about the rebellion S of Korah against Moses. Those on Korah's side were mostly Levites, men 🖁 chosen by God to take care of the tabernacle. They became jealous of Moses' leadership and wanted to take over. The story continues at verses 9-🛂 11 "And Moses said to Korah, "Hear now, you sons of Levi: is it too small a 🖁 thing for you that the God of Israel has separated you from the congregation F of Israel, to bring you near to himself, to do service in the tabernacle of the LORD and to stand before the congregation to minister to them, and that he # has brought you near him, and all your brothers the sons of Levi with you? 🕻 And would you seek the priesthood also? Therefore it is against the LORD 🕇 that you and all your company have gathered together. What is Aaron that 🕻 you grumble against him?"

Because of their rebellion, God made the ground swallow the Levites. "So 🕻 they and all that belonged to them went down alive into Sheol, and the earth closed over them, and they perished from the midst of the assembly (16:33).

It is important that men and women work together as a team, recognizing that everyone has a function to play in life. There is no room for jealousy or a envy to take place when viewing other's occupation or possessions.
