LINDA'S LINES

Last Tuesday, many of our WMU members joined together at West Broadway Baptist for the association's annual Missions Celebration. What an inspiring event! (Mark your calendar to attend next year!) The evening's preacher was Dr. Geoffrey Lacefield, Pastor of Cloverleaf Baptist Church. As Geoff reminded us of our Great Commission mandate, he shared these 2015 statistics (mainly from Barna Research) that certainly break the heart of God. I pray that these statistics will also break your heart and spur you on to finding more ways of sharing the gospel with all people.

- 95% of all professed Christians never make a conscious effort to share the gospel with a lost person.
- There are 7.4 billion people in the world; 5.8 billion are lost.
- There are 325 million people in the United States of America. 260 million are
- There are 38 million teenagers in the USA; 34 million are lost. Of the four or five million teenagers who do attend our churches, 75% of them will drop out after high school.
- 46% of young adults (ages 18-34) are classified as the "nones". They profess no religious belief or church preference.
- 80% of churches in the USA are plateaued or declining.
- Approximately 32% of church members attend worship on Sunday morning. Only 10% of church members return for Sunday evening worship.

On Wednesday evening we heard from the Evangelism Leader of the Kentucky Baptist Convention, Dr. Chuck McAlister, who challenged us to move out of our comfort zones and away from our preferences for the sake of the gospel.




