The boys of one of the Sunrise facilities, Spring Meadows Children's Home, are participants in our Open Gym program; therefore, we have the tremendous privilege of partnering "up-close" with Sunrise. As you may recall, two of the boys were baptized at our church on January 1, 2017. Praise be to God for this ministry!
