## PROVE THE TITHE SUNDAY – NOVEMBER 27

We have been given so much by the Lord; therefore, it is our privilege to give back to Him what He has entrusted to us for the work of His church, the advancement of His kingdom, and the spread of the gospel to the ends of the earth.
