Do You Hear What I Hear?

The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things they had heard and seen, which were just as they had been told. Luke 2:20, NIV

In the Christmas song, "Do You Hear What I Hear?," the night wind asks the little lamb if he sees the star up in the sky. The lamb goes to the shepherd boy and asks if he hears "a song, high above the tress, with a voice as big as the sea." The shepherd boy tells the king and the king issues an edict: "Pray for peace, people everywhere! The Child, sleeping in the night, He will bring us goodness and light!"

The song, written in 1962, does not mention the name Jesus. But, even though it is a fantasy (the wind and the lamb communicating verbally), it does echo the message of the angels who sang to the shepherds, "peace on earth," in announcing the birth of Jesus.

The inquisitive shepherds of Luke 2 rushed off to Bethlehem to see this miraculous occurrence. Immediately, they spread the news about Jesus everywhere! The people of two-thousand years ago needed to hear the good news the shepherds had for them. Luke 2:18 says, "All who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them."

The husband and wife songwriting team who wrote "Do You Hear What I Hear?" in 1962 were fearful for life because of the Cuban missile crisis. They were truly asking people to pray for peace.

Today and in every age people need to hear a message of peace from God. We need peace in our world. We need peace within ourselves. And most of all, we need peace with God. Paul wrote in Romans 5, "We have peace with God through Jesus Christ."

During this Advent and Christmas season we should be as excited as the shepherds in sharing the Good News of God's love and His peace. Check out all of the dates for our upcoming special services in this issue of "The Disciple." Note the various ways folks will be able to hear the gospel message through the ministries of Fern Creek Baptist. Share the news with family, friends, and neighbors.
