### **MARCH STUDIES**

We have a busy schedule planned for March, starting with "Cat in the Hat Day" the first week of March. The famous children's author, Dr. Seuss, was born on March 2, 1904. We will honor his legacy by celebrating his birthday and reading many of his books this month. Reading is one of the most important things you can do for and with your children, regardless of their age. Early childhood education has proven that reading aloud to a child is crucial in developing a good reader. It is also one of the most pleasurable times a parent and child can share.

In our chapel services the week of March 17, the children will celebrate Jesus triumphal entry into Jerusalem on a donkey. The children always enjoy marching around the chapel waving their handmade palm branches shouting "Hosanna! Hosanna! Blessed is the King of Israel!"

The following week we will be doing the Easter story. We explain to the children that Easter is a sad/happy event, because even though Jesus died, He rose and came alive again!!!
